
Report on Student Feedback on Curriculum 2023



 - e. 23.1 % of students (62 students)rated it as poor



- e. 23.9 % of students (64 students) rated it as poor



e.23.9 % of students (64 students) rated it as poor



- c. 27.6% of students (74 Students) rated it as good


- d. 25.4% of students (68 students) rated it as average




6. Essential efforts made by the students:


