1. WORLD MOSQUITO DAY

Context: On 10/08/2023 World Mosquito Day health awareness program was organized by the Youth Red Cross Society of College. World Mosquito Day is observed annually on **August 20** to commemorate the discovery by **Sir Ronald Ross** in 1897 that **female Anopheles mosquitoes** transmit **malaria** to humans. His breakthrough laid the foundation for combating malaria and other mosquito-borne diseases like dengue, Zika, and chikungunya.

Aim:

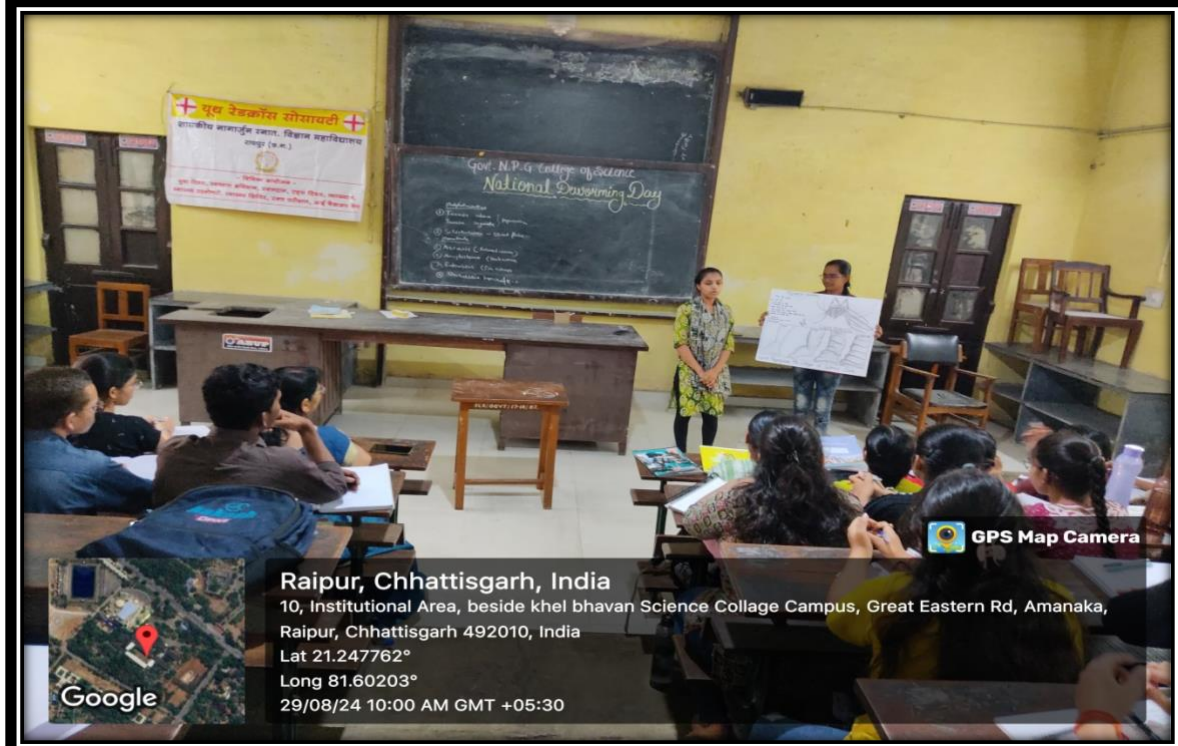
- **Reduce worm infections** (soil-transmitted helminths) that affect children's health, nutrition, and cognitive development.
- **Provide free deworming medication** (Albendazole) to children aged **1-19 years** through schools and Anganwadi centers.
- **Raise awareness** about hygiene, sanitation, and the importance of deworming.

This initiative is a key part of **India's public health efforts** to improve child development and reduce malnutrition.

Activity: Awareness of worm infection ,medication such as albendazol ,hygiene and sanitation.

Outcome : Health awareness

Context: On 13/09/2024 a blood donation camp was organized by the youth red cross society of the Govt. Nagarjuna PG College of Science Raipur.

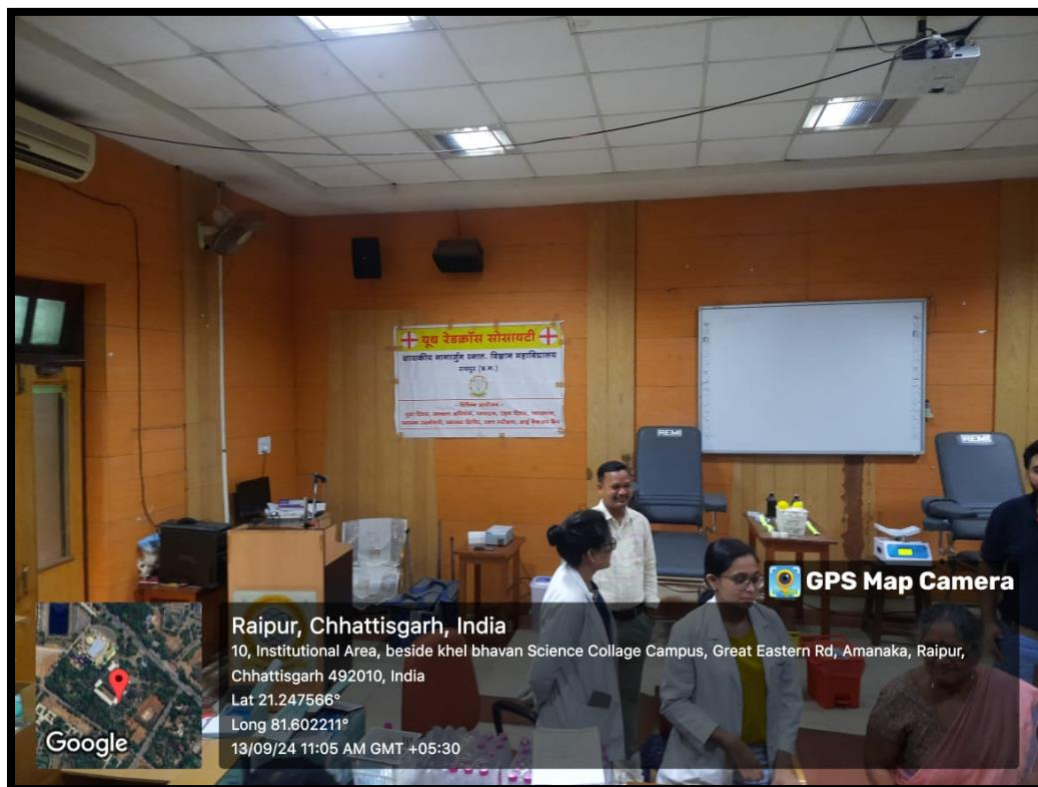
Aim: To ensure a steady supply of blood for medical emergencies, surgeries, and patients suffering from conditions like anemia, cancer, or thalassemia.

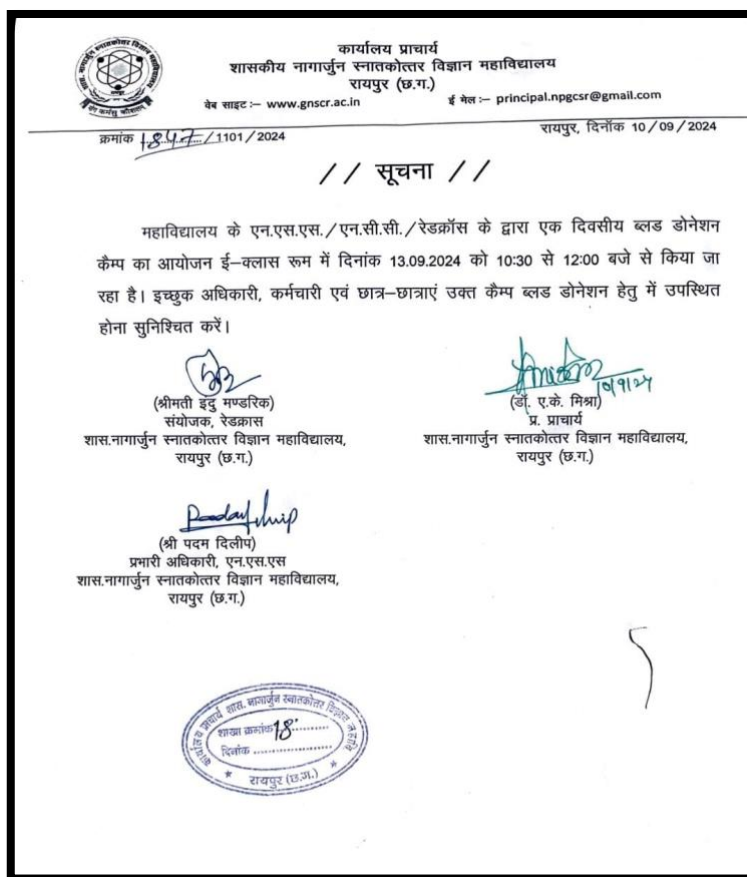
